Article the sixth... The right of the people to be secure in their persons, houses, papers, and effects, against unreasonable searches and seizures, shall not be violated, and no Warrants shall issue, but upon probable cause, supported by Oath or affirmation, and particularly describing the place to be searched, and the persons or things to be seized.

Article the seventh... No person shall be held to answer for a criminal offense, until he or she has been indicted by a grand jury.

Article the eighth... In all criminal prosecutions, the accused shall enjoy the right to a speedy and public trial, by an impartial jury of the State and district wherein the crime shall have been committed, or wherein the accused may be found, or wherein the occurrence of the crime may have taken place; and he shall be informed of the nature and cause of the accusation; he shall have the assistance of counsel for his defense; he shall be confronted with the witnesses against him; he shall have compulsory process for obtaining witnesses in his favor, and to have the assistance of counsel for his defense.



THE Conventions of a number of the States, in order to amend the Constitution, and to provide for the better execution thereof, have agreed upon the following Articles, which, when ratified by the Legislatures of the several States, shall be valid to all intents and purposes, as part of the said Constitution: ARTICLES in addition to, and confirmation of, those contained in the original Constitution.  
Article the first... After the first enumeration required by the first Article of the Constitution, the number of Representatives shall be regulated by Congress, that there shall be no more than one Representative for every fifty thousand persons.  
Article the second... No law, varying the compensation for the services of the Senators and Representatives, shall be passed in any State during the term for which they shall be chosen, and no increase of their salaries shall be made during that term.  
Article the third... Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or the free exercise thereof, or the right of citizens to peaceably assemble and to petition the Government for a redress of grievances.  
Article the fourth... A well regulated Militia, being necessary to the security of a free State, the Congress shall have the power to provide for the armament and discipline of the Militia, and to govern the Militia when called into actual service, but in no case shall the Militia be subject to the regular army or navy, when in actual service, except in such cases as may be provided for by law.

Article the ninth... In suits at common law, where the value in controversy shall exceed five dollars, no fact shall be tried by a jury, except by the consent of the parties, and the trial shall be by a jury of the State and district wherein the cause shall be brought, or by a jury of the State and district wherein the cause shall be brought, or by a jury of the State and district wherein the cause shall be brought.  
Article the tenth... Excessive bail shall not be required, nor excessive fines imposed, nor shall cruel and unusual punishments be inflicted.  
Article the eleventh... The enumeration in the Constitution, of certain rights, shall not be construed to deny or disparage others retained by the people.  
Article the twelfth... The powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited to the States by the States respectively, or to the people.
